Dear Jim Schaad,

The applications for stationary diesel emergency engine replacements and emergency vehicle replacement have been approved for funding in the amounts provided below. The replacement projects will be funded by the Community Air Protection Funds, allocated through Senate Bill (SB) 856 (Chapter 30, Statutes of 2018), which are Greenhouse Gas Reduction Funds from the California Cap-and-Trade Program. These funds are administered through the California Climate Investments (CCI) program. CCI is the overarching statewide program that puts Cap-and-Trade proceeds to work reducing greenhouse gas emissions, strengthening the economy, and improving public health and the environment – particularly in disadvantaged communities.
